What is a cookie?

When you browse the website operated by dicomLAB Dental Kft., the dicomlab.com server places so-called cookies on your computer. The cookie is an "information package that the server sends to the browser and then the browser sends back to the server every time a query is sent to the server. The cookies are created by the webserver with the help of the browser on the user's computer, where they are stored in a separate directory."¹

What are the purposes of the cookies applied by the dicomlab.com website?

- Session cookies (identifying the users after login)
These cookies ensure that after the login to the dicomlab.com site the server can connect the browsing activities of the user to an existing registration.
- Persistent cookies (ensuring a faster service for the dicomlab.com website)
Certain information indicated on the website that do not change frequently (e.g. user's surname, username) are stored by the dicomlab.com site in cookies to avoid the query from the database each time the website is viewed.
- Analytics and tracking cookies
These cookies enable us to understand how users connect to the dicomlab.com site as these cookies provide information about the pages visited and the time spent on these pages. This helps us further developing the site.
